- **BLUE SHIFT:** A HIGHER FREQUENCY (SHORTER WAVELENGTH) WHEN THE LIGHT SOURCE APPROACHES THE OBSERVER.
- **REDSHIFT:** A LOWER FREQUENCY (LONGER WAVELENGTH) WHEN THE LIGHT SOURCE MOVES AWAY FROM THE OBSERVER.

TYPES OF BLUE SHIFT
