

MEANING OF DISPERSION IN PHYSICS

UNDERSTANDING DISPERSION

THE DISPERSION OF WAVES CAN BE ATTRIBUTED TO THE PROPERTIES OF THE MEDIUM THEY ARE TRAVELING THROUGH. EACH TYPE OF DISPERSION HAS UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS AND IMPLICATIONS IN VARIOUS FIELDS OF PHYSICS, PARTICULARLY IN OPTICS AND TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

MATHEMATICAL REPRESENTATION OF DISPERSION

TO QUANTIFY DISPERSION, PHYSICISTS OFTEN USE MATHEMATICAL MODELS AND EQUATIONS.
