- **ADJOINT OPERATORS:** THE ADJOINT OF AN OPERATOR A , DENOTED $A^\dagger$, IS DEFINED SUCH THAT $\langle\psi|A\phi\rangle = \langle A^\dagger\psi|\phi\rangle$ FOR ALL STATES $|\psi\rangle$ AND $|\phi\rangle$. THIS PROPERTY IS ESSENTIAL IN QUANTUM MECHANICS, PARTICULARLY FOR ENSURING THAT OBSERVABLES ARE REPRESENTED BY HERMITIAN OPERATORS.

APPLICATIONS OF OPERATORS IN PHYSICS
