THESE TERMS ARE UBIQUITOUS, APPEARING IN EVERYTHING FROM CALCULATING THE TRAJECTORY OF A BASEBALL TO UNDERSTANDING THE ORBITAL MECHANICS OF PLANETS.

KINEMATICS: DESCRIBING MOTION

KINEMATICS IS THE BRANCH OF MECHANICS THAT DESCRIBES MOTION WITHOUT CONSIDERING THE FORCES THAT CAUSE IT. IT'S ALL ABOUT THE "WHAT" AND "HOW" OF MOVEMENT.

- **DISPLACEMENT:** THIS IS THE CHANGE IN POSITION OF AN OBJECT. IT'S A VECTOR QUANTITY, MEANING IT HAS BOTH MAGNITUDE AND DIRECTION. FOR EXAMPLE, IF YOU WALK 5 METERS EAST AND THEN 5 METERS WEST, YOUR DISPLACEMENT IS ZERO, EVEN THOUGH YOU WALKED A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 10 METERS.
- **VELOCITY:** THIS IS THE RATE OF CHANGE OF AN OBJECT'S DISPLACEMENT. IT'S ALSO A VECTOR QUANTITY, ENCOMPASSING BOTH SPEED AND DIRECTION. A CAR TRAVELING AT 60 KILOMETERS PER HOUR NORTH HAS A DIFFERENT VELOCITY THAN A CAR TRAVELING AT 60 KILOMETERS PER HOUR SOUTH.
- **ACCELERATION:** THIS IS THE RATE AT WHICH AN OBJECT'S VELOCITY CHANGES. IT CAN INVOLVE A CHANGE IN SPEED, A CHANGE IN DIRECTION, OR BOTH. WHEN A CAR SPEEDS UP, SLOWS DOWN, OR TURNS A CORNER, IT IS ACCELERATING.
- **SPEED:** THIS IS THE MAGNITUDE OF VELOCITY. IT TELLS YOU HOW FAST AN OBJECT IS MOVING, BUT NOT IN WHICH DIRECTION. THE SPEEDOMETER IN YOUR CAR MEASURES SPEED.

DYNAMICS: THE CAUSES OF MOTION

DYNAMICS, ON THE OTHER HAND, INVESTIGATES THE FORCES THAT CAUSE CHANGES IN MOTION. THIS IS WHERE WE INTRODUCE THE CONCEPTS THAT EXPLAIN WHY OBJECTS MOVE THE WAY THEY DO.

- **FORCE:** A FORCE IS AN INTERACTION THAT, WHEN UNOPPOSED, WILL CHANGE THE MOTION OF AN OBJECT. IT'S A PUSH OR A PULL. FORCES ARE VECTORS, WITH BOTH MAGNITUDE AND DIRECTION.
- **MASS:** MASS IS A FUNDAMENTAL PROPERTY OF MATTER THAT MEASURES ITS INERTIA – ITS RESISTANCE TO ACCELERATION. THE MORE MASSIVE AN OBJECT, THE HARDER IT IS TO CHANGE ITS STATE OF MOTION. IT'S IMPORTANT TO DISTINGUISH MASS FROM WEIGHT, WHICH IS THE FORCE OF GRAVITY ACTING ON AN OBJECT'S MASS.
- **INERTIA:** THIS IS THE TENDENCY OF AN OBJECT TO RESIST CHANGES IN ITS STATE OF MOTION. AN OBJECT AT REST TENDS TO STAY AT REST, AND AN OBJECT IN MOTION TENDS TO STAY IN MOTION WITH THE SAME SPEED AND IN THE SAME DIRECTION UNLESS ACTED UPON BY AN EXTERNAL FORCE. THIS IS NEWTON'S FIRST LAW OF MOTION.
- **MOMENTUM:** MOMENTUM IS A MEASURE OF AN OBJECT'S MASS IN MOTION. IT'S CALCULATED AS THE PRODUCT OF AN OBJECT'S MASS AND ITS VELOCITY ($p = mv$). MOMENTUM IS A CONSERVED QUANTITY IN A CLOSED SYSTEM.

ENERGY AND HEAT: THERMODYNAMICS TERMS

THERMODYNAMICS IS THE STUDY OF ENERGY, HEAT, WORK, AND THEIR RELATIONSHIPS. IT'S CRUCIAL FOR UNDERSTANDING EVERYTHING FROM HOW ENGINES WORK TO THE ULTIMATE FATE OF THE UNIVERSE. THE VOCABULARY HERE DELVES INTO THE TRANSFORMATIONS AND TRANSFERS OF ENERGY.

ENERGY: THE CAPACITY TO DO WORK

ENERGY IS A FUNDAMENTAL CONCEPT, DEFINED AS THE CAPACITY TO DO WORK. IT EXISTS IN MANY FORMS AND CAN BE CONVERTED FROM ONE FORM TO ANOTHER.

- **KINETIC ENERGY:** THIS IS THE ENERGY AN OBJECT POSSESSES DUE TO ITS MOTION. THE FASTER AN OBJECT MOVES AND THE MORE MASSIVE IT IS, THE GREATER ITS KINETIC ENERGY. THINK OF A SPEEDING TRAIN – IT HAS A TREMENDOUS AMOUNT OF KINETIC ENERGY.
- **POTENTIAL ENERGY:** THIS IS STORED ENERGY THAT AN OBJECT POSSESSES DUE TO ITS POSITION OR STATE. EXAMPLES INCLUDE GRAVITATIONAL POTENTIAL ENERGY (AN OBJECT HELD AT A HEIGHT) AND ELASTIC POTENTIAL ENERGY (A STRETCHED SPRING).
- **WORK:** IN PHYSICS, WORK IS DONE WHEN A FORCE CAUSES AN OBJECT TO MOVE A CERTAIN DISTANCE. IT'S THE TRANSFER OF ENERGY FROM ONE SYSTEM TO ANOTHER. IF YOU PUSH A BOX ACROSS A FLOOR, YOU ARE DOING WORK ON THE BOX.
- **POWER:** POWER IS THE RATE AT WHICH WORK IS DONE OR ENERGY IS TRANSFERRED. IT MEASURES HOW QUICKLY ENERGY IS USED OR TRANSFORMED. A HIGH-POWER ENGINE CAN DO A LOT OF WORK IN A SHORT AMOUNT OF TIME.

HEAT AND TEMPERATURE: TRANSFERRING THERMAL ENERGY

HEAT AND TEMPERATURE ARE OFTEN USED INTERCHANGEABLY IN EVERYDAY LANGUAGE, BUT IN PHYSICS, THEY HAVE DISTINCT MEANINGS.

- **TEMPERATURE:** THIS IS A MEASURE OF THE AVERAGE KINETIC ENERGY OF THE PARTICLES WITHIN A SUBSTANCE. IT INDICATES HOW HOT OR COLD SOMETHING IS.
- **HEAT:** HEAT IS THE TRANSFER OF THERMAL ENERGY BETWEEN SYSTEMS DUE TO A TEMPERATURE DIFFERENCE. IT'S ENERGY IN TRANSIT. WHEN YOU TOUCH A HOT STOVE, HEAT IS TRANSFERRED FROM THE STOVE TO YOUR HAND.
- **THERMAL EQUILIBRIUM:** THIS IS THE STATE WHERE TWO OR MORE SYSTEMS IN CONTACT HAVE THE SAME TEMPERATURE, AND THERE IS NO NET FLOW OF HEAT BETWEEN THEM.
- **THERMODYNAMICS LAWS:** THESE FUNDAMENTAL LAWS GOVERN THE BEHAVIOR OF ENERGY AND ENTROPY. THE FIRST LAW STATES THAT ENERGY CANNOT BE CREATED OR DESTROYED, ONLY TRANSFERRED OR CHANGED IN FORM. THE SECOND LAW INTRODUCES THE CONCEPT OF ENTROPY, STATING THAT THE TOTAL ENTROPY OF AN ISOLATED SYSTEM CAN ONLY INCREASE OVER TIME.

FORCES IN MOTION: ELECTRICITY AND MAGNETISM VOCABULARY

ELECTRICITY AND MAGNETISM, OFTEN UNIFIED AS ELECTROMAGNETISM, DESCRIBE THE INTERACTIONS OF CHARGED PARTICLES AND THE PHENOMENA THEY PRODUCE. THIS FIELD IS RESPONSIBLE FOR EVERYTHING FROM THE LIGHTS IN YOUR HOME TO THE WAY COMPASSES WORK.

ELECTRIC PHENOMENA

THIS AREA FOCUSES ON ELECTRIC CHARGES AND THE FORCES THEY EXERT.

- **ELECTRIC CHARGE:** A FUNDAMENTAL PROPERTY OF MATTER THAT CAUSES IT TO EXPERIENCE A FORCE WHEN PLACED IN AN ELECTROMAGNETIC FIELD. CHARGES CAN BE POSITIVE OR NEGATIVE. LIKE CHARGES REPEL, AND OPPOSITE CHARGES ATTRACT.
- **ELECTRIC CURRENT:** THE FLOW OF ELECTRIC CHARGE, TYPICALLY ELECTRONS, THROUGH A CONDUCTOR. IT'S MEASURED IN AMPERES (A).
- **VOLTAGE:** ALSO KNOWN AS ELECTRIC POTENTIAL DIFFERENCE, VOLTAGE IS THE ELECTRICAL POTENTIAL ENERGY PER UNIT CHARGE. IT'S THE "PRESSURE" THAT DRIVES ELECTRIC CURRENT. MEASURED IN VOLTS (V).
- **RESISTANCE:** THE OPPOSITION TO THE FLOW OF ELECTRIC CURRENT. MATERIALS WITH HIGH RESISTANCE IMPEDE CURRENT FLOW. MEASURED IN OHMS (Ω).
- **ELECTRIC FIELD:** A REGION AROUND A CHARGED OBJECT WHERE ANOTHER CHARGED OBJECT WILL EXPERIENCE A FORCE.

MAGNETIC PHENOMENA

MAGNETISM DEALS WITH MAGNETIC FIELDS AND THEIR EFFECTS.

- **MAGNETISM:** A PHYSICAL PHENOMENON PRODUCED BY MOVING ELECTRIC CHARGES AND MAGNETIC MOMENTS OF ELEMENTARY PARTICLES OF MATTER. IT'S WHAT MAKES MAGNETS STICK TO REFRIGERATORS.
- **MAGNETIC FIELD:** A REGION AROUND A MAGNETIC MATERIAL OR A MOVING ELECTRIC CHARGE WITHIN WHICH THE FORCE OF MAGNETISM ACTS.
- **MAGNETIC POLE:** THE TWO ENDS OF A MAGNET, THE NORTH POLE AND THE SOUTH POLE, WHERE THE MAGNETIC FIELD IS STRONGEST.
- **ELECTROMAGNETISM:** THE INTERACTION OF ELECTRIC CURRENTS OR FIELDS AND MAGNETIC FIELDS. A CHANGING MAGNETIC FIELD CAN INDUCE AN ELECTRIC CURRENT, AND AN ELECTRIC CURRENT CAN CREATE A MAGNETIC FIELD.

THE NATURE OF LIGHT: OPTICS TERMS

OPTICS IS THE BRANCH OF PHYSICS THAT STUDIES THE BEHAVIOR AND PROPERTIES OF LIGHT, INCLUDING ITS INTERACTIONS WITH MATTER AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF INSTRUMENTS THAT USE OR DETECT LIGHT.

PROPERTIES OF LIGHT

UNDERSTANDING LIGHT INVOLVES GRASPING ITS WAVE-PARTICLE DUALITY.

- **LIGHT:** ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIATION THAT CAN BE DETECTED BY THE HUMAN EYE. IT EXHIBITS PROPERTIES OF BOTH WAVES AND PARTICLES.
- **WAVELENGTH:** THE DISTANCE BETWEEN SUCCESSIVE CRESTS OF A WAVE, ESPECIALLY POINTS IN A SOUND WAVE OR ELECTROMAGNETIC WAVE. THIS DETERMINES THE COLOR OF VISIBLE LIGHT.
- **FREQUENCY:** THE RATE AT WHICH A WAVE OSCILLATES. HIGHER FREQUENCY MEANS SHORTER WAVELENGTH AND MORE ENERGY.
- **REFLECTION:** THE BOUNCING OF A WAVE OFF A SURFACE. THIS IS WHY WE CAN SEE OBJECTS – LIGHT REFLECTS OFF THEM INTO OUR EYES.
- **REFRACTION:** THE BENDING OF A WAVE AS IT PASSES FROM ONE MEDIUM TO ANOTHER. THIS OCCURS BECAUSE THE SPEED OF THE WAVE CHANGES IN DIFFERENT MEDIA, SUCH AS LIGHT MOVING FROM AIR INTO WATER.
- **DIFFRACTION:** THE BENDING OF WAVES AROUND OBSTACLES AND THE SPREADING OUT OF WAVES PAST NARROW OPENINGS.
- **SPECTRUM:** A RANGE OF ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIATION THAT HAS BEEN SORTED ACCORDING TO WAVELENGTH OR FREQUENCY. THE VISIBLE SPECTRUM INCLUDES THE COLORS OF THE RAINBOW.

BEYOND THE CLASSICAL: MODERN PHYSICS VOCABULARY

MODERN PHYSICS ENCOMPASSES THEORIES DEVELOPED IN THE EARLY 20TH CENTURY, PRIMARILY QUANTUM MECHANICS AND

RELATIVITY, WHICH REVOLUTIONIZED OUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE UNIVERSE AT ITS MOST FUNDAMENTAL LEVELS.

QUANTUM MECHANICS: THE REALM OF THE VERY SMALL

QUANTUM MECHANICS DESCRIBES THE BEHAVIOR OF MATTER AND ENERGY AT THE ATOMIC AND SUBATOMIC LEVELS. IT'S A WORLD WHERE PROBABILITIES OFTEN TRUMP CERTAINTY.

- **QUANTUM:** THE SMALLEST DISCRETE AMOUNT OF A PHYSICAL ENTITY (SUCH AS ENERGY OR MOMENTUM) THAT CAN EXIST ON ITS OWN.
- **PHOTON:** A QUANTUM OF LIGHT, A PARTICLE OF ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIATION. IT HAS NO MASS AND TRAVELS AT THE SPEED OF LIGHT.
- **ELECTRON:** A STABLE SUBATOMIC PARTICLE WITH A NEGATIVE ELECTRIC CHARGE. ELECTRONS ORBIT THE NUCLEUS OF AN ATOM.
- **ATOM:** THE BASIC UNIT OF A CHEMICAL ELEMENT, CONSISTING OF A NUCLEUS (PROTONS AND NEUTRONS) AND ELECTRONS.
- **WAVE-PARTICLE DUALITY:** THE CONCEPT THAT EVERY ELEMENTARY PARTICLE OR QUANTUM ENTITY CAN EXHIBIT THE PROPERTIES OF BOTH A PARTICLE AND A WAVE.
- **HEISENBERG UNCERTAINTY PRINCIPLE:** A FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE STATING THAT THERE IS A LIMIT TO THE PRECISION WITH WHICH CERTAIN PAIRS OF PHYSICAL PROPERTIES OF A PARTICLE, SUCH AS POSITION AND MOMENTUM, CAN BE KNOWN SIMULTANEOUSLY.

RELATIVITY: SPACE, TIME, AND GRAVITY

EINSTEIN'S THEORIES OF RELATIVITY REDEFINED OUR UNDERSTANDING OF SPACE, TIME, GRAVITY, AND THE UNIVERSE.

- **SPECIAL RELATIVITY:** DEALS WITH THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN SPACE AND TIME FOR OBJECTS MOVING AT CONSTANT SPEEDS IN THE ABSENCE OF GRAVITY. KEY CONCEPTS INCLUDE TIME DILATION AND LENGTH CONTRACTION.
- **GENERAL RELATIVITY:** A THEORY OF GRAVITATION THAT DESCRIBES GRAVITY NOT AS A FORCE, BUT AS A CURVATURE OF SPACETIME CAUSED BY MASS AND ENERGY.
- **SPACETIME:** A UNIFIED FOUR-DIMENSIONAL CONTINUUM FORMED BY THREE DIMENSIONS OF SPACE AND ONE DIMENSION OF TIME.
- **BLACK HOLE:** A REGION OF SPACETIME WHERE GRAVITY IS SO STRONG THAT NOTHING—NO PARTICLES OR EVEN ELECTROMAGNETIC RADIATION SUCH AS LIGHT—CAN ESCAPE FROM IT.

PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER: WHY PHYSICS VOCABULARY MATTERS

A: IN PHYSICS, "ENERGY" IS A PRECISELY DEFINED QUANTITY REPRESENTING THE CAPACITY TO DO WORK. IT'S A CONSERVED QUANTITY THAT CAN TRANSFORM BETWEEN DIFFERENT FORMS (KINETIC, POTENTIAL, THERMAL, ETC.) BUT CANNOT BE CREATED OR DESTROYED. IN EVERYDAY LANGUAGE, "ENERGY" CAN BE USED MORE LOOSELY TO REFER TO VITALITY OR POWER.

Q: WHAT IS THE SIGNIFICANCE OF VECTOR QUANTITIES IN PHYSICS VOCABULARY, SUCH AS VELOCITY AND FORCE?

A: VECTOR QUANTITIES ARE ESSENTIAL BECAUSE THEY HAVE BOTH MAGNITUDE AND DIRECTION. UNDERSTANDING THIS DIRECTIONAL COMPONENT IS CRITICAL FOR ACCURATELY DESCRIBING AND PREDICTING PHYSICAL PHENOMENA. FOR EXAMPLE, KNOWING THAT A FORCE HAS BOTH STRENGTH AND DIRECTION IS VITAL FOR CALCULATING HOW AN OBJECT WILL MOVE.

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
