HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF COGNITIVE NEUROSCIENCE

THE INTRODUCTION OF FUNCTIONAL MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING (fMRI) AND POSITRON EMISSION TOMOGRAPHY (PET) ALLOWED RESEARCHERS TO VISUALIZE BRAIN ACTIVITY IN REAL-TIME. THESE INNOVATIONS PAVED THE WAY FOR A MORE EMPIRICAL APPROACH TO UNDERSTANDING THE BRAIN'S ROLE IN COGNITION. COGNITIVE NEUROSCIENCE EMERGED AS A DISTINCT DISCIPLINE, AIMING TO BRIDGE THE GAP BETWEEN THE MIND AND THE BRAIN.

RESEARCH METHODS IN COGNITIVE NEUROSCIENCE
