THE FOUNDATIONS OF ECLECTIC PSYCHOLOGY

ECLECTIC PSYCHOLOGY EMERGED AS A RESPONSE TO THE LIMITATIONS OF TRADITIONAL PSYCHOLOGICAL THEORIES THAT OFTEN ADHERED STRICTLY TO A SINGLE PARADIGM. RENOWNED PSYCHOLOGISTS SUCH AS CARL ROGERS AND ABRAHAM MASLOW CONTRIBUTED TO THE FOUNDATION OF ECLECTIC APPROACHES BY EMPHASIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF INDIVIDUAL EXPERIENCES AND THE SUBJECTIVE NATURE OF REALITY.

AT ITS CORE, ECLECTIC PSYCHOLOGY IS BUILT ON THE PREMISE THAT HUMAN BEHAVIOR IS INFLUENCED BY A MULTITUDE OF FACTORS, INCLUDING BIOLOGICAL, PSYCHOLOGICAL, AND SOCIAL DIMENSIONS. ADAPTIVE FLEXIBILITY

BY FOSTERING AN EMPATHETIC ENVIRONMENT AND HELPING CLIENTS TO EXPRESS THEIR FEELINGS FULLY, THERAPISTS CAN SUPPORT CLIENTS IN ACHIEVING SELF-ACTUALIZATION AND PERSONAL GROWTH. COMBINING THIS WITH BEHAVIORAL STRATEGIES CAN PROVIDE A WELL-ROUNDED APPROACH TO TREATMENT.
