DEGREE TYPES AND SPECIALIZATIONS

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCESSES

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR PSYCHOLOGY COLLEGES IN CALIFORNIA CAN VARY SIGNIFICANTLY DEPENDING ON THE INSTITUTION AND THE LEVEL OF THE PROGRAM. GENERALLY, UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS WILL REQUIRE A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR EQUIVALENT, ALONG WITH STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES, SUCH AS THE SAT OR ACT. MANY COLLEGES ALSO CONSIDER EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND PERSONAL STATEMENTS IN THEIR ADMISSIONS DECISIONS.

GRADUATE ADMISSIONS

FOR GRADUATE PROGRAMS, APPLICANTS TYPICALLY NEED TO HOLD A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY OR A RELATED FIELD. GRADUATE PROGRAMS OFTEN REQUIRE STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES, SUCH AS THE GRE, LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION, AND A STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OUTLINING THE APPLICANT'S RESEARCH INTERESTS AND CAREER GOALS. IT IS ESSENTIAL FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS TO RESEARCH EACH PROGRAM'S SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS CAREFULLY.

A: A BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY TYPICALLY TAKES FOUR YEARS TO COMPLETE, WHILE A MASTER'S DEGREE USUALLY REQUIRES AN ADDITIONAL TWO YEARS, AND A DOCTORAL DEGREE CAN TAKE ANYWHERE FROM 4 TO 7 YEARS, DEPENDING ON THE PROGRAM.

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
