ABNORMAL PSYCHOLOGY

FORENSIC PSYCHOLOGY

FOR STUDENTS DRAWN TO THE INTERSECTION OF PSYCHOLOGY AND LAW, FORENSIC PSYCHOLOGY OFFERS INSIGHTS INTO CRIMINAL BEHAVIOR, LEGAL PROCESSES, AND THE ROLE OF MENTAL HEALTH IN THE JUSTICE SYSTEM. THIS ELECTIVE PREPARES STUDENTS FOR CAREERS IN LAW ENFORCEMENT, LEGAL CONSULTING, OR CRIMINAL JUSTICE.

SPECIALIZED COURSES AND CONCENTRATIONS
